Just a short walk from Whistler Village and directly across the way from the Whistler Conference Centre, the Arnold Palmer designed [Whistler Golf Club](#) features broad fairways interlaced with gentle streams and framed by grand old-growth Douglas firs and ancient cedars.

Nestled between Green Lake and the River of Golden Dreams, the [Nicklaus North Golf Course](#), masterfully designed by Jack Nicklaus, boasts incredible glacial mountain views. After a round on the greens, indulge in delicious food at the notable Table Nineteen featuring unparalleled views of Green Lake and snow-

capped peaks in the distance.

Carved into the flanks of Blackcomb Mountain, [Fairmont Chateau Whistler Golf Club](#), designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr., is framed by tall Douglas fir and granite rock. Along with traversing across creeks and ponds, it has an elevation change of more than 400 feet creating a unique golfing experience that is not to be missed.
